

Lane Construction Wins Two Contracts Totaling Close to \$400 Million

CHESHIRE, CT ±The Lane Construction Corporation, the U.S. subsidiary of Salini Impregilo Group, has won two contracts in the road and water sectors for a combined total of nearly \$400 million. The contracts contribute to W K H F R P S O C H A P \$1 billion worth of new orders in the United States for 2018 of Wade Avenue

[REDACTED] The work involves replacing pavement and bridges and upgrading interchanges and is expected to start in early 2019 and be completed by mid-2023.

The contract reaffirms Lane as the #3 top highway builder (ENR) in the United States, and a leader in the transportation sector overall. Other contracts won in this sector this year include the Wekiva Parkway (Section 8) in Florida; the I-10 Corridor Contract 1 Express Lanes in California; and the widening of I-85 in South Carolina.
